- 1) This appeal by the accused/appellant under Section 14-A(2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 is directed against the order dated 19/10/2020 passed by the Special Judge (S.C./S.T. Act), Dhamtari (C.G.), refusing to allow his regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. The appellant is in jail since 24/09/2020 in connection with Crime No. 172/2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 363, 366 & 376 of IPC, under Sections 4 & 6 of POCSO Act and under Section 3 (2)(v) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Magarlod, District Dhamtari (C.G.).
- 2) At the very outset, learned counsel appearing for the appellant seeks to withdraw this appeal with liberty to file afresh appeal at the appropriate stage.

- 3) Shri Vishnu Dhruv, father of the prosecutrix is connected through video conferencing from District Legal Service Committee, Dhamtari and raised objection to release of the appellant on bail.
- 4) Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as stated above.
