1. This petition has been brought only with prayer for issuance of direction to the learned Family Court, Janjgir, District- Janjgir-Champa, C.G.
2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has filed an application under Section 13(1)(A) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, praying for decree of divorce. The application was filed on 03.03.2021, but the case has not even been registered so far.
