Heard.

1. The applicant has been arrested in connection with Crime No.212/2021 registered at Police Station – Sariya, District - Raigarh (C.G.) for alleged commission of offences under Section 20-B of the NDPS Act, 1985.
2. Case of the prosecution is that from the possession of the applicant, 4 kgs of *ganja* was recovered.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant would submit that the applicant has not committed any offence, he has been falsely implicated and the quantity recovered is more than small quantity but less than commercial quantity. He further submits that the applicant is in jail since 26/09/2021.
4. Learned State counsel opposes bail application.
5. I have heard learned counsel appearing for the parties and perused the

case diary.

6. Taking into consideration the nature and gravity of allegations, facts and circumstances of the case, pre-trial detention of the applicant and also that the *ganja* recovered is more than small quantity but less than commercial quantity, this Court is of the view that present is a fit case for grant of bail.

7. Accordingly, the bail application is allowed. It is directed that the applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1 lakh with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court for his appearance as and when directed.
