1. Heard.
2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has filed a representation on the basis of circular issued by State Government dated 11.9.2019 No. F4-07/Seven-1/2019. A representation was filed on 17.8.2021. About two months are over since the representation was

filed as there is a specific instruction in the circular dated 11.9.2019 that any such application for allotment has to be disposed of within a period of two months which has not been disposed of, therefore, prayer has been made for issuance of specific direction.
