Hon'ble Justice Shri N.K. Chandravanshi**Order on Board****18-11-2021**

1. Heard.
2. The applicants have preferred the first bail application under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, as they are arrested in connection with Crime No.544/2021, registered at Police Station – Urga, District – Korba (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Section 34 (2) (क) of the Chhattisgarh Excise Act.
3. Prosecution story, in brief, is that on 29-10-2021, the applicants were found in joint illicit possession of 30 bulk liters of country made liquor (*Mahua*).

4. Learned counsel for the applicants would submit that the applicants are innocent, they have been falsely implicated in the instant case and they are in jail since 29-10-2021. He further submits that this is the first crime registered against both the applicants. Hence, they may be enlarged on bail.
5. Learned counsel for the State would oppose the bail application filed by both the applicants. He further submits that as per case diary, no criminal antecedent has been found registered against the applicants.
6. After hearing learned counsel for both the parties; taking into consideration that this is the first crime registered against the applicants; quantity of seized liquor recovered from them and also their period of detention, I feel inclined to enlarge the applicants on bail.
7. Accordingly, the present bail application is allowed. It is directed that if each of them furnishes one solvent surety for a sum of Rs.25,000/- along with one personal bond in the like sum to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned for their appearance before the concerned Court as and when directed by the said Court, they be released on bail.
