3. Taking into consideration, the acquittal is granted against acquisition of committing sexual assault on a minor girl.
4. On the aspect of grant leave to appeal, learned counsel for the State would argue that though the prosecutrix has clearly stated regarding commission of rape on her and the prosecution led specific evidence with regard to the age of prosecutrix, trial Court has acquitted the appellant.
