1. Heard on I. A. No.01/2019, an application for condonation of delay of 74 days in filing this M.C.C.

It is contended by learned counsel for the Applicant that since the Petitioner was not aware regarding the rejection of his Contempt Petition, dismissed on 07.08.2019, therefore, the instant petition for restoration of the same could not be filed on time and has filed the same immediately upon knowing the said fact.
