Taking into consideration the submission of learned State counsel that though the prosecution led clinching circumstantial evidence that the deceased, appellant's brother died homicidal death in his own house and at that time only appellant was at home and other members of the family were not in the house and recovery of blood stained club and blood stained cloths of the accused has been proved, acquittal has been granted, we are inclined to grant leave to appeal. Accordingly, CRMP is **allowed**.
