Party in person applicant-Anil Ganjidhar Pawar is present. Mr. Wagh learned counsel for respondent No. 3 and learned APP for respondents No. 1 and 2 are present.

2. Applicant No. 1 - Party in person submitted that his purpose of filing the present proceeding will be served, if the direction is given to the trial Court to dispose of his matter pending before it expeditiously.
