ORDER :-

Inspite of service of notice, no appearance on behalf of respondent no.3 – acquiring body. Learned AGP appearing for respondent nos.1 and 2 objects to condone the delay. There is delay ranging between 653 days and 1076 days, respectively, in filing the appeals by the agriculturists whose lands have been compulsorily acquired for public purpose.

2. For the reasons given in the applications, the same are allowed in terms of prayer clause (B), on condition that the applicants shall not be entitled for interest or any monetary benefits for the delayed period.

3. In appeals, issue notice to the respondents, returnable after ten weeks. Respective learned AGP waives notice for respondent nos.1 and 2 in respective matter.
