FINAL ORDER :

3. Mr. Dhongade, the learned counsel for the respondent No. 2 on instructions submits that, the respondent No. 2 would decide the objection of the petitioner on its own merits, in

accordance with law and within a period of four (04) weeks from today and till the objection of the petitioner is decided the amount would not be disbursed to any one.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned advocate for the respondent No. 2, no further orders are necessary. The writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
