2. In spite of service of notice, there is no appearance on
behalf of respondent No.2 – Acquiring Body. Learned AGPs object to

4. For the reasons given in the applications, the same are allowed in terms of prayer clause (B), provided that the applicants shall not be entitled for interest for the delayed period of 1502, 1445, 1383, 489, 489 and 1539 days, respectively.

6. On registration of appeals, issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 19th January, 2022.
