PER COURT : -

1. The learned Advocate for the informant - wife, respondent no. 2 herein, submits that the marital discord between her husband applicant no. 1 and his relatives, applicant nos. 2 to 8, has been amicably resolved. The informant and her husband have applied for divorce by mutual consent and she prays for quashing of the FIR against the applicants, in this backdrop.

2. In view of the above, this petition is allowed by consent in terms of prayer clause 'A' & 'B' (first), which read as under : -

A] "The Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to issue appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of writ and thereby quash and set aside the FIR filed against petitioners bearing Crime No.289/2016, under section 498A, 406, 323, 504, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, registered with Shirpur City Police Station, Shirpur, District. Dhule."

B] "The Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to issue appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of writ and thereby quash and set aside the Proceedings of Regular Criminal case No. 123/2017 pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Shirpur District. Dhule."
