**ORDER :-**

. Both the learned Advocates submit that the purpose of Criminal Application No.361 of 2019 has been served. The applicant therein had withdrawn the amount which was deposited by the respondent therein. Under such circumstance, Criminal Application No.361 of 2019 stands disposed of.

2. Today, the learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners intend to deposit amount of Rs.86,000/- towards the arrears, but she prays for time of four weeks to deposit the same.

towards arrears within a period of two weeks from today.

4. If that amount is deposited within that period, then the respondent in writ petition is allowed to withdraw the same.
