1 I have heard learned Counsel for the petitioner at length.

2 The learned Counsel for the petitioner has vehemently submitted that as to how the Divisional Joint Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Nasik, has passed the order of interim stay erroneously and the effect thereof.

3 However, instead of going into the merits of the case, since substantive appeal is pending before the Divisional Joint

Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Nasik, it would be just and appropriate if the Divisional Joint Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Nasik, is directed to dispose of the appeal within two months from the date of this order.

4 In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the Divisional Joint Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Nasik, to dispose of the pending appeal No.A-30 of 2020 within two months from the date of this order.

5 Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of.
