PER COURT:

1. We have heard the learned Advocate for the applicant and the learned A.G.P. appearing on behalf of respondent No.2. None present for respondent No.1.

2. We have perused the earlier orders of this Court, dated 10/10/2014 in Civil Application No.10008/2014, dated 18/04/2015 in Civil Application No.4589/2015 and dated 27/04/2015 in Civil Application No.4589/2015, all in First Appeal No.1041/2014.
