1. Mr B.R. Kedar holding for Mr V.B. Sargar, learned counsel for the appellants and Mr R.R. Sancheti, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2 are present.
2. This Court vide order dated 21st December, 2021 was pleased to refer the terms of compromise to the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court for verification and report.
3. Accordingly, the learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court has submitted the report today and marked as 'Y' for identification.
4. Mr B.R. Kedar, learned counsel for the appellants and Mr R.R. Sancheti, learned counsel for the respondents submitted that the appeal has been amicably settled between the parties in view of the terms of compromise which are verified by the learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.

5. The Second Appeal needs to be disposed of in view of terms of compromise.

On perusal of report of learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court, it is noticed that the Registrar (Judicial) has verified the terms of compromise as well as the parties through their respective counsels. - (vi) In view of disposal of Second Appeal, Civil Application also stands disposed of.
