- . We have heard Mr. Jain, learned counsel for the petitioner.

Mr. Bagul, learned counsel for the respondent submits that subsequent to the order impugned in the present writ petition, the respondent has issued a letter to the petitioner on 15.06.2021 directing the petitioner to submit certain documents so that the proposal can be forwarded to the higher office.
