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PER COURT :-

1. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner for some time.
2. It appears that the petitioner has not filed any complaint in the Police Station nor approached to the Court by filing any private complaint. It further appears that civil suit is also pending between the parties. In view of the same, preventive action as requested by the petitioner may not be possible due to the pendency of the civil litigation.
