3. The petitioner may approach the Chief Executive Officer by filing an application. The petitioner may apply to the Chief Executive Officer

for transfer on the ground of couple convenience. The Chief Executive Officer shall consider the application of the petitioner on its own merits, in accordance with law and policy, expeditiously and preferably within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of application of the petitioner.
