PER COURT:-

1. The petitioner No.1 seeks permission to terminate the pregnancy. The petitioner No.1 was referred to the Expert Committee at Government Medical College and Hospital at Aurangabdd. The Expert Committee has examined the petitioner No.1 and submitted the report. Relevant part of the report reads thus :
