1. We have heard Mr. Ansari, learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.G.P. for the respondents.

2. The Respondents / State has placed on record the Panchanama showing that the vehicle has been seized by the Circle Officer and the Talathi.

3. The learned A.G.P. submits that the petitioner has a remedy of appeal.

5. If the petitioner files an appeal, then the Appellate Authority shall consider the application of the petitioner for release of vehicle preferably within a period of thirty (30) day's from the date of filing appeal before it.
