PER COURT :-

Mr. Advant, learned counsel for applicant-petitioner submits that, the writ petition is filed challenging the demand notices and the provisions of the Maharashtra Village Panchayat Act. Learned counsel submits that after filing the writ petition, petitioner has realized that some facts are remained to be pleaded in the petition. Now, the same are required to be brought on record and pleaded in the memo of petition.
