PER COURT :

1. Learned counsel for respondents No. 1 and 2 states on instructions that this matter has become infructuous as certificate under Section 101 of Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act is challenged in this petition. He submits that the borrower has repaid entire loan amount and the bank has issued 'No Dues' certificate to the borrower. He further states that by order dated 28th November, 2014, petitioner was directed to make statement as to why the petition should not be dismissed so as to enable the petitioners to

avail of the statutory remedy provided under Section 154 read with Section 2A of the Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act, 1960. Such a statement is not yet made.

2. In view of this, petition stands dismissed for non-compliance of order dated 28th November, 2014.
