PER COURT:-

1. The petitioners in the present writ petition are seeking directions against the respondents to disclose the bifurcation of the fees charged under the caption of the term fees.

2. During the course of argument, the learned counsel for the respondent refers to the Maharashtra Educational Institutions (Regulation of Fee) Act 2011. It appears that there is a mechanism provided for redressal of the grievance made by the petitioner in the present writ petition.

3. In view of that, it would not be appropriate for us to consider the petition on the merits, so also the argument of the respondents regarding the fees of the institution vis-a-vis un-aided institution.

4. The petitioner may take steps as contemplated under the Act, 2011.

5. For the grievances regarding the purchase of books and uniforms, the committee is already constituted as per the Government Resolution dated 26.02.2020. The petitioner may approach the authorities in that regard.

6. In case, the petitioner approach the authorities, all contentions of the petitioner and respondents are kept open.

7. The writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
