1. Heard. Perused the impugned award.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents objects to permit withdrawal of the amount.
3. It is a death claim. The amount involved is not more than Rupees Eight Lakhs. In the fitness of things, the applicants are permitted to withdraw 70% of the amount under the impugned award alongwith interest accrued thereon on submitting usual undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registrar

(Judicial) of this Court, 50% of which be paid to the widow of the deceased and 20% be paid equally to the parents of the deceased. Balance 30% amount be invested in fixed deposit with any of the nationalised bank.

4. Civil application stands disposed of accordingly.
