2 The petitioner impugns the order passed under Section 68 of the Wakf Act by the Collector.

3 In that event, the petitioner has remedy as provided under Section 68 of the Wakf Act itself.

4 In light of that, we are not inclined to consider the petition on merits.

5 The writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the alternate remedy. All contentions kept open. No costs.

6 For a period of five days from today, the *status-quo* as on today be maintained so as to enable the petitioner to avail the alternate remedy.

7 Needless to state that on lapse of five days, the protection granted to the petitioner shall come to an end.
