2. So far as regards applicants are concerned, it is the case of composite negligence, although, the Tribunal has apportioned the liability as 80:20 between the owners of two vehicles, one of whom is in appeal before this Court.

3. In the fitness of things, the applicants are permitted to withdraw 75% of the amount in deposit with this Court along with interest accrued thereon on furnishing usual undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.
