PER COURT :

1. Mr. Jadhavar, learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that the validation proceeding was disposed of as the committee found the caste certificate is not in proper form and proper nomenclature, and not issued by the competent authority. The petitioner applied for the correct caste certificate in the proper form. The petitioner is issued with the fresh caste certificate with the proper nomenclature and form. However, the committee has not accepted the same and insisting to file fresh proposal along with documents.

2. The petitioner certainly has to file the fresh proposal

which the petitioner shall file in accordance with the law. After filing the fresh proposal, the petitioner can give an application to the committee for return of all the documents and the committee shall after verifying it, return the documents to the petitioner and the petitioner shall file the same with the present proposal. Thereafter, the matter be decided by the committee. It is submitted that the vigilance is already conducted while deciding the earlier matter. Naturally, the vigilance is a matter of record which can also be considered by the committee. If the petitioner files additional documents, naturally the committee will have to conduct the vigilance for the same also. The committee shall decide the proposal expeditiously.

3. Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
