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PER COURT :-

1. Shri M.G.Patil, learned counsel for the applicant submits that parties have arrived at out of Court settlement. He has placed on record compromise deed. He submits that he does not want to proceed with the revision application.
2. In view of compromise effected between the parties, revision application is disposed of as withdrawn.
3. Since offence is compounded, applicant is acquitted of the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. Judgment and order of the trial Court in S.C.C. No.287 of 2013 dated 18th September, 2017 and Judgment and order of the Additional Sessions Judge in Criminal Appeal No.27 of 2017 dated 15th October, 2019, are set aside.
4. All pending applications stand disposed of.
