1. Heard.
2. Leave to correct figures mentioned in the application.
3. Liability to pay compensation is fastened on the insurance companies of both the vehicles. Earlier, one insurance company has deposited the amount to the extent of 50%. Now, Reliance insurance company-respondent No. 2 has deposited remaining 50% amount.
4. Learned counsel Shri Rathi for respondent no. 2 objects to withdrawal of the amount on the ground that there is dispute as to

the liability to pay the amount of compensation.

5. Keeping the rights of the parties open, the applicant is permitted to withdraw 75% of the amount of compensation deposited by respondent No. 2.

6. Civil application stands disposed of.
