ORAL JUDGMENT (Per: T.V.Nalawade J.):-

1. Rule. Rule made returnable forthwith.

3. Present application is filed for relief of quashing of C.R. No.318 of 2019 registered with Dhule City Police Station, Dhule for the offence punishable under Sections 498A, 406, 323, 504 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code. The crime has been registered on the basis of report filed by respondent No.2, who is wife of applicant No.1.
