5. We make it clear that we have not examined the allegations made by the Petitioner against Respondent No.2 herein. Therefore, all contentions of all parties on this issue are expressly left open.

6. The petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms. There shall be no order as to costs. All concerned to act on an authenticated copy of this order.
