In view thereof, the respondent nos.3 & 4 are directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners dated 24th June 2021 (Exhibit-‘E’ at page 29 of the petition) within a period of six weeks from today. The respondent nos.3 & 4 shall communicate decision to the petitioners within one week from the date of decision.

4. The petition is accordingly disposed of in aforesaid terms. Rule is made absolute accordingly. There shall be no order as to costs.
