1. Learned counsel Ms. Megha Bajoria appointed for the appellant submitted that though the appeal is of the year 2020, paper-book is prepared and the appeal is ready for hearing. It is then submitted by the learned counsel for the appellant that as the evidence of prosecution is in the form of four witnesses, the appeal may not require lengthy submissions or arguments. Considering very limited number of witnesses as well as considering the fact that the appellant was daily-wage contract labourer and now is the sole survivor in the family, the oral prayer of the learned counsel for the appellant for the early hearing of appeal is allowed.

the early hearing of appeal is allowed, she will not press the application for bail. The application is not pressed and is accordingly disposed of.
