

2. The learned advocates identify their respective parties, who are present in the court.
3. The amount of Rs.12 lakhs, by cheque as mentioned in the terms, is handed over to the learned advocate representing respondent No.1.
4. It is jointly submitted that this petition can be disposed off in terms of X-1.
5. In view of the above, this petition and the interim application stand disposed off.
6. Rule is discharged.
7. By consent, the amount deposited before the Labour Court by the petitioner is permitted to be withdrawn, under proper identification, along with accrued interest.
