1. On 18/02/2020, while admitting the applicant to the pre-arrest bail, this court has recorded as under:

“4. Though the charge-sheet against the co-accused has been filed, prosecution could not point out reasons for seeking custody of the applicant. It may also be stated that there are no criminal antecedents against the applicant. Applicant is permanent resident of Mumbai and he would always be available for investigation.
