Learned Counsel for the respondent No.1 states that pursuant to the order dated 30th March 2021, the respondent No.1 filed a *pursis* in the trial Court, seeking withdrawal of the case (D.V. proceedings) filed by her in the Court of the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 62nd Court, Bhoiwada, Dadar, Mumbai.
