No. 751/2020 registered with MHB Police Station for offence punishable under Sections 499, 402 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 and 25 of the Arms Act and Section 37(1)(A), 135 of Maharashtra Police Act upon furnishing P.R. bond in the sum of Rs. 15,000/- with one or more sureties in the like amount.

(ii) Applicant shall neither influence the prosecution witnesses in any manner nor tamper with the evidence.

(iii) Till the charge is framed, applicant shall attend the concerned police station in the first week of every English calendar month.
