Learned counsel for the parties have amicably settled their dispute and have filed the consent terms dated 23.02.2021 before the Family Court, Nashik and by order dated 23.02.2021 the parties have been granted mutual consent divorce under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.
