Nayana Panchal expired at Government Medical College and Hospital, Nagpur on 3rd June, 2019. In view thereof, the Revision filed by the said Smt. Nayana Panchal against conviction stood abated.

3 That, by an Order dated 1st April, 2021 passed in Criminal Interim Application No.1690 of 2019 filed by the Applicant Mr. Prakash Menda, Respondent No.3-Ms. Madhavi R. Patil, was impleaded in the present proceedings in her capacity as well-wisher of Ms. Nayana Panchal.

4 In view of the fact that, Applicant Mr. Prakash Menda and the Respondent No.3 Ms. Madhavi R. Patil, have now settled the matter amicably, nothing survives in the present Application and the same is accordingly disposed off.
