1. At the outset, learned APP, on instructions, makes a statement that the investigating agency does not want to arrest the applicant. The statement is recorded and accepted.

2. In this situation, learned counsel for the applicant does not press this application.

3. It is clarified that, if in future, if the investigating agency needs her arrest in connection with the same offence, the investigating agency shall give four clear working days' notice to

the applicant to enable her to take appropriate steps to protect herself. The applicant shall attend the concerned police station, as and when called, and shall co-operate with the investigation.

4. With this direction, the application is disposed of as not pressed.
