1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant.
2. Perused the order passed by this Court on 29.04.2021 in Criminal Revision Application No.121/2014 and other connected matters. The revision application preferred by the applicant was dismissed. The

applicant was directed to surrender himself before the learned Trial Court within two weeks from the date of order i.e. 29.04.2021.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant seeks to challenge the said order of dismissal before the Apex Court, hence, he seeks further time for surrender. He also submits that due to pandemic, he is unable to contact his advocate at New Delhi. Therefore, some time is required for preparation of papers for filing it before the Apex Court. Hence, he seeks extension of time to surrender before Trial Court.
