1 By this petition the petitioner has sought quashing of notice dated 05/08/2020 whereby he was required to remain present on 14/08/2020.

2 It is pointed out by Mr. H S Venegaonkar, the learned counsel appearing for the Respondent-CBI that since the date specified in the impugned notice for appearance of the petitioner is already over, therefore, nothing survives in the present writ petition for consideration.

3 We are in agreement with the aforesaid submission and it is clear that in so far as the impugned notice dated 05/08/2020 is concerned, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous with passage of time.
