. By this Application, the Applicant has sought amendment of the Criminal Appeal. The Applicant who is appearing in person has sought to add several grounds specified in paragraph B-1 to P-11 of the Application. The grounds at B-1 to N-8 relate to the challenge to the order of the Appellate Court.
