1. I have heard Mr.Salvi, learned Counsel for the petitioners and Mr.Suresh Kumar, learned Counsel for the respondents-railways.

The issue in these petition is in regard to the interest benefit claimed under Section 33-C of the Industrial Disputes Act by these petitioners having succeeded in the proceedings under the Industrial Disputes Act, initiated by them.
