2. The basic grievance of the Petitioner, as we understand from the oral argument, is that even though the Petitioner is acquitted, he is being treated as convicted in the documents filed by the State in the other proceedings against the Petitioner.

3. To appreciate this grievance, the order of the acquittal should be on record, the documents in which the State Authorities

are taking contrary stand, as contended, should be on record. Pleadings should be in reference to these documents. None of these basic documents are placed on record. The learned Counsel for the Petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the Petition with liberty to file a fresh Petition with precise prayers and all necessary documents.

4. The Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of with liberty.
