2. The Appellant's authorized signatory is present. Respondent Nos.1 and 2 are present. They were identified their respective Advocates. They have filed their Consent Terms. The Consent Terms are taken on record and marked as 'Annexure-A' for identification.

3. As per the Consent Terms, an amount of Rs.18,38,095/- was deposited on 13/01/2016 before the Claims Tribunal, Satara. Out of that amount, Appellant is entitled to withdraw an amount of Rs.2,50,000/- along with accrued interest from 13/01/2016. The

remaining amount along with accrued interest which was deposited before the Claims Tribunal, be paid to the Respondent Nos.1 and 2 in equal proportion. Hence, the following order :-

- (a) The Appeal is disposed of in terms of the Consent Terms.
- (b) Appellant is entitled to withdraw an amount of Rs.2,50,000/- along with accrued interest from 13/01/2016. The remaining amount along with accrued interest which was deposited before the Claims Tribunal, be paid to the Respondent Nos.1 and 2 in equal proportion.
- (c) Statutory deposit along with accrued interest thereon, be transferred to the concerned Claims Tribunal forthwith.
- (d) R&P, if any, be sent back forthwith.
- (e) Court fees, as permissible under the rules, be refunded.
- (f) All pending Civil Applications, if any, stand disposed of.
