1 The learned counsel for the Petitioner seeks liberty to delete Respondent Nos.3 and 4. Leave to amend is granted. Amendment shall be carried out forthwith. Re-verification is dispensed with.

2 Rule.

Rule is made returnable forthwith.

The learned AGP waives service for the State.

By consent of the parties, the matter is taken up for final hearing.

3 By this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India the Petitioner seeks an order and direction against

Respondent No.2 to consider the proposal made on 24.06.2029 annexed at Exhibit-H to the petition which is still pending since the date of filing.

4 We accordingly, direct Respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the said proposal dated 24.06.2019 within six weeks from today, without fail, and shall communicate the order to the Petitioner within a week thereafter.

5 If any adverse order is passed against the Petitioner, no coercive steps shall be taken against the Petitioner for a period of three weeks from the date of order.

6 If the proposal is accepted by Respondent No.2, all consequential benefits shall be granted to the Petitioner within four weeks from the date of communication of the order.

7 It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any view on merits of the matter.

8 Rule is made absolute in the aforesaid terms.

9 Writ Petition stands disposed of accordingly. No order as to costs.

10 Parties to act on an authenticated copy of this order.
