1] Applicant is seeking pre-arrest bail in C.R. No. 1104/2021 registered with Tulinj Police Station for Offences punishable under Sections 420 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 52,53 and 54 of Monopolistic and Restrictive Trade Practice Act.

2] Mr. Kanjuraman, learned counsel for the applicant would urge that structure is standing since long and action is initiated at belated stage that too without any basis. It is claimed that applicant is

innocent, there are no antecedents and custodial interrogation is not warranted.

3] I have perused the complaint and other material on record.

4] It can be inferred at the face value that applicant has carried out illegal construction and sold structures therein to the occupiers and as such committed an offence of cheating.

5] There is a strong prima facie case of involvement of the applicant in an offence of cheating. As such, no case for bail is made out. Application stands rejected.
